| Adolf Hitler | 2020 | “Women must earn less than men, because they are weaker, they are smaller, they are less intelligent” |
| Austin Mitchell (British Politician, Labor Party) | 2017 | “We call on you to finally take note of the fact that women also have a right to self-determination over their bodies and their lives. We call on you all to stop the everyday sexism here in Parliament” |
| Björn Höcke (far right wing AfD-politician in Germany) | 2015 | “There’s many women now who think, “Surely we don’t need feminism anymore, we're all liberated and society’s accepting us as we are.” Which is ball hogwash. It’s not true at all.” |
| Cheryl Rios (American business women) | 2015 | “The man's world is big compared to the woman's. The man belongs to his duty, and only now and then does a thought wander over to the woman. The woman's world is the man. She only thinks about other things from time to time.” |
| Elizabeth Cady Stanton (US suffragette) | 2012 | “The best protection any woman can have... is courage.” |
| Janusz Korwin-Mikke (Polish politician and member of the European Parliament at the time) | 2005 | “A good wife doesn't disagree with her master in public and a good little girl doesn't lie about why she quit politics.” |
| Petra Jelínková (Green Party at district level in Prague) | 1983 | “...in the past all history was made by males. At the moment that women are beginning to share in the making of the world, this world still belongs to men: men have no doubt about this, and women barely doubt it.”/“women’s entire history has been written by men” |
| Simone de Beauvoir (writer, philosopher and one of the most known feminists) | 1949 | “... a female shouldn't be president. Let the haters begin . . . but with the hormones we have there is no way we should be able to start a war. (...) being the President, that should be left to a man, a good, strong, honorable man.” |
| Waltraud Schoppe (German politician of the Green Party) | 1934 | "We need to rediscover our masculinity. Because only when we rediscover our masculinity will we become manly. And only when we become manly will we become defensive, and we must become defensive, dear friends!" |
| Yoko Ono (artist, filmmaker and singer) | 1848 | “I remember I went to a public discussion on social policy and the very first question I received from the host was, So, it must be really hard for your husband – when do you do the ironing for him? Do you even iron his shirts?” |
